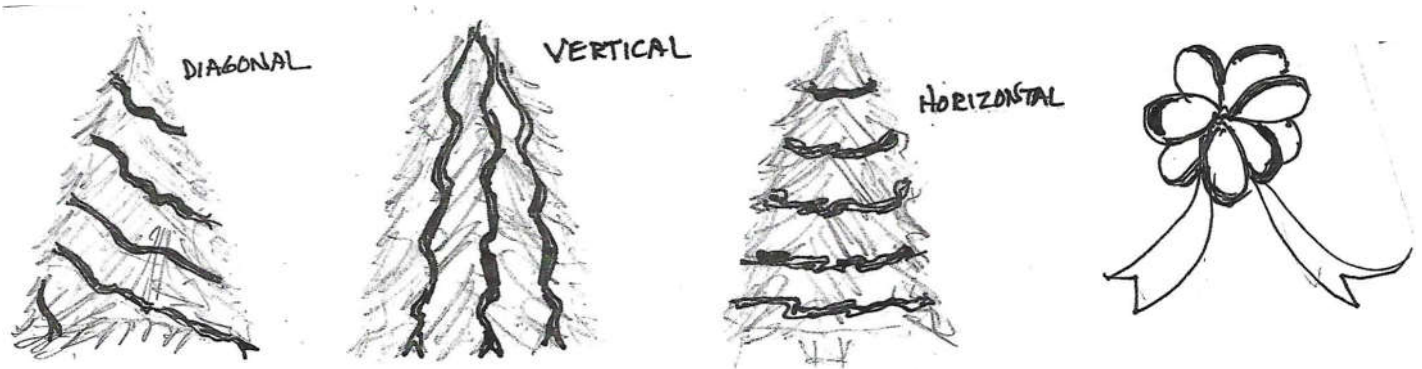


RIBBON REQUIREMENTS BY TREE SIZE

Requirements depend on slim or wide tree body; bow toppers require additional ribbon



For all Styles of ribbon application:

TREE SIZE	RIBBON SIZE	ORIENTATION	TOTAL YARDS
3 feet tall	2" – 3" wide	Diagonal, Vertical, Horizontal	5-10 yards
4 feet tall	3" wide (ideal)	Diagonal, Vertical, Horizontal	10 yards
5 feet tall	3" (slim) or 4" (full)	Diagonal, Vertical, Horizontal	10-15 yards
6 feet tall	4" wide	Diagonal - 4 tracks	16 yards (3.5 – 4 yards each)
6 feet tall	4" wide	Vertical - 4 trails	15 yards (+/- 3.5 yards each)
6 feet tall	4" wide	Horizontal - 5 circles	20 yards
7 ½ feet tall	4" wide or more	Diagonal - 5 tracks	20 yards (4 yards each)
7 ½ feet tall	4" wide or more	Vertical - 5 trails	20 yards (4 yards each)
7 ½ feet tall	4" wide or more	Horizontal - 6 circles	25 yards

Bows:

BOW SIZE	TOTAL YARDS
6" – 7" diameter	3-4 yards (depending on loop quantity and tail size)
10" – 11" diameter	+/- 6 yards (depending on loop quantity and tail size)

TIPS:

- When purchasing ribbon be sure to double-check that the quantity is listed in YARDS, not feet.
 - If listed in feet, then divide by 3 to calculate yards.
- Wired and/or stiff ribbons work best on trees.
- Net-type ribbons can catch or snag on branches; use with caution.
- Garland lengths can be calculated in the same way as ribbon.
- For best results, secure your ribbon every couple of feet using floral wire or color-matched pipe cleaners.
